Conditions, Rules & Regulations and responsibilities of Eidfest Stallholders and other participants

1. Stallholders

- a. All stall bookings must be done on the official Eidfest stall application form.
- b. Full and correct payment must accompany the completed and signed Eidfest Stall application form by set deadlines.
- c. Direct deposit may be made into National Australia Bank account No 084402 59-095-7135 with a copy of the deposit slip posted or faxed with the stall booking form.
- d. Ensure you have received a receipt of payment.
- e. Stallholders will be notified of the final stall allotment.
- f. Eidfest reserves the right to reject any application for the hire of stalls. Rejected applicants will be informed and their hire fee refunded. The decision of Eidfest is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- g. Stalls may be cancelled by Eidfest due to space restrictions with the refund of hiring fee less \$30 administration fee. No refund of hiring charges shall be given if the stall is cancelled within 2 weeks of Eidfest.
- h. The decision of the Eidfest will be final and binding on all stall hiring matters.
- i. Stallholders shall nominate one contact/spokesperson for their stall in order to liaise with the Eidfest stalls committee.
- j. Stallholders shall bring own utensils, power leads, and appliances. Power will only be available for low wattage appliances and additional power requirements must be pre arranged. Only gas stoves may be used and electric hotplates are not allowed. Charcoal based heaters will be allowed only under exceptional strict negotiable conditions.
- k. All stallholders must comply with all statutory regulations and requirements in relation to Business, Health and Safety requirements and workers compensation requirements.
- l. All electrical leads have to have testing tags and are to be kept above the ground for safety reasons. Facilities for on site testing and tagging will be made available on the day (fee available on application).
- m. All stallholders must have public liability insurance. Stallholders must provide a certificate of currency for public liability insurance. If you are not covered then Eidfest can arrange insurance on your behalf (fee available on application).
- n. All deliveries and set up of stalls are to be completed by 10am on the morning of Eidfest.
- o. All stallholders must ensure that the speed limit of 15k/h is strictly adhered to all times while driving vehicles in the ground area, which included entry and exit.
- p. No vehicles are to be parked in the main ground area during the event, unless authorised.
- q. Stallholders shall not carry out any construction work, including interference with any electrical work or digging of ground.
- r. Stallholders will not play or cause to play or allow the playing or sounding of any musical instrument, radio or any musical device in hirers stall whether or not it interferes with the public address system or with any other entertainment provided at the ground.
- s. Vehicular access to the ground and to the hirers stall shall be through a designated route to be specified by the organising committee.
- t. That the hirer shall give the numbers of vehicles to be used for loading and unloading at hirer's stall to the organising committee at least 5 days in advance. (This will allow time to notify ground security).
- u. That security officers employed to supervise activities during Eidfest will be allowed all reasonable access to stalls for the purpose of checking compliance with this agreement and the rules of the organising committee or the owners of the show ground.

2. Islamic Values and Regulations

- a. Stallholders shall not display, sell or promote materials contrary to the Islamic value system and way of life. This includes obscene CD's, videos, computer games, posters etc.
- b. Games of chance, *haram* goods such as pork products, alcoholic beverages, and addictive drugs including cigarettes shall be strictly forbidden.
- c. Eidfest is an Alcohol free zone. No alcoholic drinks shall be allowed in the Mt Gravatt Showground and no alcoholic drinks shall be consumed in the stalls and surrounding areas. Persons under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs will be refused entry into the grounds.
- d. All food items must comply with Islamic dietary guidelines of HALAL food items.
- e. All items to be displayed or sold by stallholders should be listed in the application forms and it will be at the discretion of the Eidfest Committee to accept or reject any other the items listed on Islamic grounds.
- f. Any literature, banners, photographs, video or display undermining the unity of the Muslim Ummah or any material objectionable or offensive to the government authorities shall not be allowed. The Eidfest Committee reserve the right

to get any objectionable display removed instantly.

- g. The decision of the Eidfest Stalls Committee will be final and binding in determining what items may not be sold or distributed from the stall or anywhere at the Showgrounds.
- h. Non-compliance of the above will result in the immediate closure of the stall without any refund of the stall hiring fee and the refundable deposit.
- i. It is expected that all participants will be dressed modestly at the event.

3. Food Stalls

- a. Food stallholders must ensure that only HALAL products are sold from their stalls.
- b. Food stallholders must read and comply with the Brisbane City Councils "information on the requirements for Food stalls" available from the council offices or its website.
- c. The council health inspector or the organizers of Eidfest reserve the right to close the stall immediately in the event of non compliance with food safety or Halal requirements without refund of the stall hiring fee and any other money's paid. Further fines may be imposed by the council health inspectors for non-compliance.
- d. Eidfest is not responsible for any power failure at any stage during the day.
- e. Cleanliness must be maintained throughout the day as well as at the end of the festival.
- f. Electrical appliances are limited to a maximum of 2.4kw power using a standard 10 amp (GPO). If you require 15 amps or 3-phase appliance then you must purchase a circuit for each appliance through Eidfest.
- g. All extension leads MUST have testing tags and to be kept above the ground.
- h. All stallholders are responsible for charges and fines imposed by statutory bodies.
- i. All stallholders are to provide a container for collection of waste oil. Stallholders will be held liable for nay damages caused to the grounds through the spilling of oil.
- j. Stallholders will be held liable for any damage caused to any property within the showground.
- k. In accordance with Brisbane City Council food stall regulations all food stalls are required to have their floors covered completely

4. Right of Admission

- a. Eidfest reserves the right to refuse admission to the event or evict any persons deemed to be in breach of any of the above rules and regulations and/or found in the opinion of the organisers of Eidfest to be displaying objectionable behaviour.

5. Limited Liability and Indemnity

- a. Stallholders agree to indemnify and hold Eidfest harmless to any fine, claim, action or legal demand arising from or incidental to the operation of the stall including, but not limited to any breach by the stallholders of local government laws and regulations.
- b. Eidfest will not be liable for claims in respect of personal injury or property damage arising directly or indirectly out of or caused by, through, or in connection with any stall, exhibit or display operated, controlled, maintained or organised by the stallholder.
- c. Eidfest will not be liable for claims in respect of personal injury or property damage arising directly or indirectly out of or caused by, through, or in connection with the act or omission of any hired labourer, independent contractor, subcontractor or their employees who is engaged by the stallholder to perform work in connection with the stallholders business or his/her stall.
- d. Should the event be cancelled or interrupted for any reason, none of the fees paid will be refunded, and no liability will attach to Eidfest, its organisers or its representatives.
